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# Pass it On

It was July of 1960. I had just turned four, and I was with my parents and two older sisters spending a week at Family Camp at Pilgrim Hills. I remember, in my four-year-old mind, how excited I was when my mom let me walk down a grassy hill back to our cabin all by myself – knowing my mom was actually watching me every step of the way. For years afterwards, I smiled at that memory anytime I walked that same hill. My dad forever said that spending that week at Pilgrim Hills changed his life.

As a tween, I headed off to camp at Templed Hills for the first time. I'd never been away from home by myself before, so I was nervous, but I was with three friends from church so that was a comfort. I remember I had a bright orange and pink sleeping bag (hey, it was the '60s!), and I can still vividly picture the inside of my cabin.

All through high school I attended Pilgrim Hills every summer. Many of the same teens came year after year, so we formed very deep, lasting friendships. We sang our hearts out in the dining hall after every meal, shared sacred moments around campfires, and stayed up way too late every night. That's where I first learned the song, "Pass it On," and where the presence of God became extremely real for me in new and transformative

My mother served on the Board for Outdoor Ministries for decades. Her love and commitment to the camps

ran deep. All four of my children attended church camp every summer. And for many years the DCC Confirmation retreat, and our Women's and Men's retreats.



have been held at the camps. For me, there is no place on earth more sacred than Pilgrim and Templed Hills.

So, it was heartbreaking when the decision was made back in 2017 to sell Pilgrim Hills due to financial constraints. Now, unfortunately, the same decision has been made regarding Templed Hills. I understand the decision, but it is an extremely sad "good-bye."

This year, then, will be the final chance to attend a Women's retreat at Templed Hills. I encourage all who are able to sign up. Our Second Mile offering for February goes to Outdoor Ministries. Every penny is needed in order to be able to continue programming through 2024, so please consider a Second Mile gift. And I encourage all to sign up for one of the camps offered this summer. I know that the transforming power of Outdoor Ministries will indeed live on, and I am grateful.

# Wait! I'm Not Ready Yet!

Having three older brothers, I grew up playing a lot of sports at home. There was basketball in the barn, football alongside the cornfield, and baseball in the backyard. Even though we played a lot, I confess that I was never very good at baseball. I especially remember how bad a batter I was. My brother Brad would pitch the ball and it would soar right by me nearly every time. I can remember the words I so often called back to him: "Wait! I wasn't ready yet!"

That's sort of how I feel as the Lenten season approaches this year. It was just Christmas. And here we are again already, with only days until Ash Wednesday is upon us. The ball is being thrown toward home plate, and I want to shout, "Wait! I'm not ready yet!"

Every year we take this journey toward the cross, and sometimes it is not an easy one. As we journey through sacred story, contemplating Christ's pain and suffering, it can touch something very deep within us. Sometimes, the journey asks us to travel down difficult roads we are not quite ready to face.

The Lenten season is one of preparation. It exists in order to help us get ready. But ready for what? While it is true that the Lenten journey takes us down many shadowed paths, it is ultimately preparing us for the joy of new life at Easter. As we look ahead at what is to come, we recognize that the cross does not only mean grief and despair, but that through and beyond the cross God revealed amazing love, enduring grace, and ultimate victory. Scripture tells us that the people of Jesus' own time were not prepared for the gifts that were given to the world in the death and resurrection of Christ.

Even in the darkest of days of the Lenten journey, we are called to be an Easter people—focused on the promises of God fulfilled in the gift of resurrection that is to come. The great gift is coming. And it comes for all of us—ready or not!


